

Green Teen Team Health and Safety Policy - January 31 2021

Green Teen Team recognises the requirement to conduct its business in such a way as to ensure so far as is reasonably practicable that:

1. Employees, voluntary staff, members and guests and other people who may be affected by their operations and activities are not exposed to risk to their health and safety.
 2. Young people participating in activities organised by GTT are not exposed to risks to their health and safety.
 3. Members of the public and visitors or persons providing services to GTT are not exposed to risks.
 4. Proper regard is given to the protection of the environment.
- The overall responsibility for health and safety management throughout the organisation is vested with the Directors.

GTT expects all staff to:

5. To conduct their activities to the standard of any health and safety procedures required by GTT.
6. Conduct all activities in order to meet the requirements of the GTT's policies.
7. Prepare a Risk Assessment statement in respect of events concerning the health and safety of those attending.

GTT believes that procedures for health and safety and providing quality service go together and reaffirms that safety is a major consideration in all aspects of its activities.

To achieve this aim GTT will:

9. Ensure all staff have appropriate Health and Safety briefing.
10. Ensure, in respect of activities organised by GTT, that all activities and events are risk assessed so that as far as is reasonably practicable all risks are eliminated or reduced to an acceptable level.

All GTT staff are responsible and accountable for implementing this Health and Safety Policy within their respective fields of work. A copy of this statement will be readily accessible and a copy given to all staff and volunteers.
